



No receipts in excess of £50 are reckoned in the calculations. The deduction of 6s. 8d. in the £ is made in every case. The calculation on the basis adopted came to £699 6s. 8d. The balance of 13s. 4d. was utilized by adding four-pence to each of the above-mentioned 35 Libraries, and also adding the remaining 1s. 8d. to the Lefroy Library.
