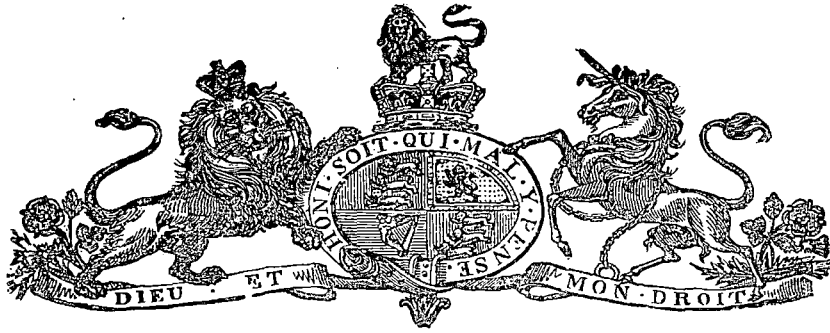

NATIONAL AUSTRALASIAN CONVENTION :

REPORTS OF THE DELEGATES APPOINTED BY EACH  
HOUSE.



*To the Honorable the President and Members of the Legislative Council.*

WE, the Members of the Legislative Council who were appointed by your Honorable Council to act with four Members of the House of Assembly as Delegates to the National Australasian Convention that was convened to consider and report upon an adequate scheme for a Federal Constitution for the Australasian Colonies, have the honor to report to your Honorable Council—

That the Australasian National Convention, composed of Delegates from all the Australasian Colonies, met at Sydney on the 2nd day of March in the present year, and brought its labours to a close on the 9th day of April last.

After a careful and mature deliberation, the accompanying draft Bill to constitute the Commonwealth of Australasia was adopted for submission to the Legislatures of the several Colonies, and we have now the honor to present the same, together with a full Report of the Proceedings of the Convention,\* to your Honorable Council.
