

REPORT FOR 1900.

Lands Titles' Office, Hobart, 22nd April, 1901.

Sir,

I have the honour to submit to you the Annual Report on the working of this Department for the year ending 31st December last.

The Expenditure for the year was £2866 7s. 8d., made up as follows:-

The amount paid for advertising forms no charge on the revenue, as it is prepaid by Applicants for Titles.

The receipts under The Real Property (Torrens) Act were £3539 14s, as against £3316 0s. 6d. in 1899; £2868 6s. 6d. in 1898, £2595 10s. 4d. in 1897, £2435 11s. 6d. in 1896, and £2436 5s. in 1895, showing an increase of nearly 50 per cent. in the last five years.

As Collector of Stamp Duties, I have personally received £2974 12s. 6d. in cash on various documents submitted for assessment and payment of duty under The Stamp Duties Acts; £2295 2s. 6d. duty has been paid on Instruments which it is my duty to see duly stamped, and the bulk of which are actually stamped in my presence before they are passed for registration in this Office. Most of these bear adhesive stamps, so that a small proportion only of the amount is included in first-mentioned cash collection. These figures show that the machinery of the Torrens Office, although not established for revenue purposes, has been the medium of collecting £6514 6s. 6d. in cash over and above the amounts paid as Stamp Duty in adhesive stamps on the Instruments registered in it.

^{*} Many of these, of course, represent new loans to take up old ones, and are not additional encumbrances on the privately-owned lands in the State.

Three hundred and fifty eight surveyors' diagrams and plans, from actual survey, have been examined and checked, according to the best up-to-date principles, and as all the detail calculations and requisitions, and the correspondence, are permanently attached to the plans, the record remains to show for itself how faithfully the work has been performed.

The Assurance fund, on 31st December last, amounted to £8287 17s., as against £7804 15s. 11d. at the end of the previous year. This fund is a source of confidence to the public, and must always be carefully conserved, as it is impossible to say when it may be called upon to meet claims.

The Board of Lands Titles Commissioners, held 46 meetings, and dealt with 206 applications of various kinds.

I am well satisfied with the amount of business transacted during the past year, and judging by the receipts for the first three months of the current year, I expect to be able to make an even more satisfactory report at its close.

I have to thank the legal profession for their cordial and courteous co-operation with me, in dealing with their business through the department.
