3. In all Rural Municipalities the Wardens and Council Clerks have continued to attend to the duties of Chief Magistrate and Bench Clerk respectively.

4. No Warden of any Rural Municipality has declined to continue to perform the duties of Chief Magistrate, and no Council Clerk the duties of Bench Clerk.

5. No remuneration (other than those in lieu of fees under "The Local Courts Act, 1896,") has been agreed to be paid for the performance of the duties of Chief Magistrate and Bench Clerk, or either of them.
