



PARLIAMENT OF TASMANIA.

HOBART FIRE BRIGADE BOARD:

REPORT FOR 1893.

Presented to both Houses of Parliament by His Excellency's Command.



REPORT of the Fire Brigade Board for the City of Hobart for the Year ending 31st December, 1893, made pursuant to Clause 13 of "The Fire Brigades Act, 1883."

During the year the services of the Firemen composing the Brigade have been required at 22 fires and alarms, and their duties have been carried out in an efficient manner.

The net expenditure amounts to £784 10s. 5d., which is divided equally between the Government, the Corporation, and the Insurance Companies.

An Account of the Receipts and Expenditure is attached to this Report; also a Schedule of the Fires attended by the Brigade.

The Superintendent reports that all the fire engines and other appliances the property of the Board are in good order.
