

# LAUNCESTON FIRE BRIGADE BOARD: REPORT FOR 1893.

REPORT of LAUNCESTON FIRE BRIGADE BOARD for Year ending 31st December, 1893.

To the Right Honorable Viscount Gormanston, Knight Commander of the Most Distinguished Order of St. Michael and St. George, Governor and Commander-in-Chief in and over the Colony of Tasmania and its Dependencies.

#### MAY IT PLEASE YOUR EXCELLENCY:

In pursuance of "The Fire Brigades Act," 47 Vict. No. 21, this Board has the honor to report as follows:—

During the year the Brigade attended at twenty-nine alarms and fires, and performed their duty in a satisfactory manner.

The total expenditure for the year, after deducting the amounts recovered on uninsured property and unclaimed amounts, is £845 Is. 5d., divided equally between the Government, Municipal Council, and Insurance Companies.

There have been eleven meetings of the Board during the year.

The Fire Escape mentioned in our previous Reports has arrived, and gives satisfaction.

In view of the rapid growth of Trevallyn it was decided in April last to establish a Reel-station in that suburb. The reel for same was locally constructed, and the complete plant is considered a great protection to the District.
