

POST ANDDEPARTMENT. TELEGRAPH

General Post Office, Hobart, 6th May, 1897.

I HAVE the honor to place before you a Report on the Post and Telegraph Department of Tasmania for the year 1896, showing its receipts and expenditure, and the general working of its several branches. I am pleased to say that the receipts for 1896 exceed those of the previous year by £17,049 8s. 7d., and that a further saving in expenditure of £657 15s. 7d., as compared with 1895, was effected. For the purposes of comparison the figures for 1895 are shown in brackets.

Revenue.—The amount collected under this head was £81,586 10s. 4d. [£64,537 1s. 9d.], thus apportioned:—Postage, £51,521 13s. 2d. [£37,905 15s. 2d.]; revenue stamps, £8000; money order commission, £2674 12s. 6d. [£1988 4s. 6d.]; profit earned under item Savings Banks, £1048 0s. 10d. [£530 0s. 2d.]; private boxes, mail-bags, fines, &c., £696 5s. 6d. [£623 1s. 10d.]; poundage on postal notes, £212 14s. $8\frac{1}{2}d$. [£167 18s. 3d.]; telegraph receipts, £14,051 8s. $3\frac{1}{2}d$. [£12,273 5s. 7d.]; telephone rentals, £3381 15s. 4d. [£3048 16s. 3d.].

The number of stamps sold were:—Adhesive, 6,895,920; post cards, 226,428; embossed envelopes, 10,488; registration envelopes, 1560; and value of impressed, £14,837 12s. 8d.; 10,641 exchanges were made, representing £240 5s. 10d. This latter amount did not enhance

The above shows an increase in the aggregate of stamps, post cards, and embossed envelopes, of 1,248,228, and a decrease in registration envelopes of 204. The large increase in number of adhesive stamps used is explained by the fact that telegrams are now paid for by means of stamps.

Parcels Post.—6927 inland parcels were posted during the year 1896, an increase of 946 over 1895, and 1637 ship parcels were posted, an increase of 173 over 1895.

There was also collected £1952 3s. 9d. on account of Customs dues on 10,922 packets and

parcels valued at £11,902 15s. 3d., which were received from the United Kingdom and Colonies, which amount went to credit of Customs Department.

Expenditure.—The expenditure amounted to £61,314 0s. 10d. [£61,971 16s. 5d.], made up of salaries and allowances, £29,089 2s. 0d. [£27,859 7s. 6d.]; conveyance of mails, £21,940 14s. 2d. [£23,447 2s. 1d.]; miscellaneous, £1217 9s. 2d. [£1291 5s. 1d.]; stationery and stores, £2008 16s. 10d. [£1451 8s. 1d.]; cable subsidies, £2144 4s. 3d. [£2371 10s. 10d.]; additions, repairs, and maintenance of lines, £4913 14s. 5d. [£5551 2s. 10d.]

Mail Matter.—Under this head 4,444,300 [4,206,347] inland letters were despatched, an increase of 237,953 on previous year; 2,876,040 [1,486,029] ship letters received and despatched, an increase of 1,390,011; 231,451 [202,332] post cards; 2,343,550 [1,351,551] packets were dealt with; and it is estimated that 4,861,893 [4,506,191] newspapers passed through the Office. Of these letters and packets, 1,029,401 [995,994] were franked, and consequently did not contribute to the revenue.

Dead Letter Branch.—37,789 [28,395] unclaimed letters (122 registered) were disposed of, inclusive of some 1700 [1500] "special request."

Post Offices opened during 1896.—Eight (including one old office re-opened).

Post Offices closed.—Seven.

Number of Miles of Post Roads at end of year, 2495 [2426]; and 1,200,530 [1,171,415] miles were travelled during the year.

Inland Mail Service.—Very satisfactorily carried out, contractors giving little or no trouble to the Department.

Federal Mail Service.—This service expired 31st January, 1896, but was extended on same terms for a further period of two years. The terms of the new contract were agreed to in Sydney in January, 1896, and the tenders of the Peninsular and Oriental Company and the Orient Company, both for seven years, have been accepted by United Kingdom at a saving of £20,000 on the price formerly paid (£435,000) for the India, China, and Australian services. It is possible, therefore, that a considerable saving will be effected in the amount which this Colony pays for this service.

Intercolonial Mail Service.—The third year of contract has been very satisfactorily carried out by the Union Steamship Company, and a new contract for a further term has now been arranged.

Money Orders.—During the year 89,091 [84,116] orders for £179,301 3s. 10d. [£165,040 10s. 10d.] were issued; 186,320 [71,606] for £258,926 12s. 5d. [£146,702 2s.] were paid. The commission collected on issues was £2176 15s. 9d. [£2091 4s.]

Post Office Savings Banks.—£86,547 12s. 3d. [£78,717 7s. 1d.] was received as deposit during the year, including £3395 19s. 3d. [£3447 8s. 2d.] apportioned to depositors as interest; £67,652 15s. 1d. [£62,784 14s. 2d.] was withdrawn, leaving a balance of £133,889 8s. 2d. [£114,994 11s.] to credit of investors; 3302 accounts were opened, 1911 were closed, and 8176 remained open at close of year, as against 6785 in 1895.

Postal Notes.—30,411 [23,696] were sold, aggregating £9688 6s. $8\frac{1}{2}d$. [£7871 2s. $4\frac{1}{2}d$.] in amount.

Extensions of lines during the year are—Fingal to Mangana, 5 miles; Gormanston to Queenstown, 5 miles; Stanley to Forest, 5 miles; Coppington to Kellevie, 3 miles; Berriedale to Glenlusk, 6 miles. *Under construction*.—Glenora to Ellendale, 12 miles.

Tasmania's liability in respect of cable subsidies and traffic guarantees continues to be still further reduced, the amount paid for year ended 30th April, 1896, being £2094 4s. 5d., as against £2321 11s. for previous year. The New Zealand cable was the only one on which the receipts were less than the guaranteed revenue, this Colony's proportion of the loss being £169 17s. 5d.
