



C H U R C H G R A N T S.

PETITION FROM THE SYNOD.

Presented by Mr. Chapman, and ordered by the House to be printed,  
30 August, 1859.



*To the Honourable the House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled.*

The humble Petition of the undersigned Members of the Synod of the United Church of England and Ireland in Tasmania.

RESPECTFULLY SHOWETH :

THAT the distribution of that portion of the reserved Revenue which is appropriated to the Church of England, exclusive of the Bishop's stipend and allowances, has been hitherto limited to the Ministers of twenty-nine Districts of the Colony, called Colonial Chaplaincies, and marked A. in the subjoined Schedule.

That the Synod of the United Church of England and Ireland in Tasmania has recognised nine other Districts, marked B. in the subjoined Schedule, as possessing the same claim with the aforesaid twenty-nine to be considered full Cures or Incumbencies.

That there are also certain other Cures which are of sufficient importance to return Representatives to the Synod, and which receive the ministrations of the Church of England, though they do not at present possess resident Ministers, which Cures are marked C. in the subjoined Schedule.

That the nine Cures recognised by the Synod as Incumbencies have an equitable right to an equal share in the public grant with the twenty-nine Colonial Chaplaincies; and that the remaining Cures are worthy of receiving some provision from the said Grant.

That your Petitioners therefore pray that, in appropriating the said portion of the Revenue, your Honourable House will favourably consider the following scheme, which includes all the three cases above mentioned.

And your Petitioners will ever pray, &c.
