

PETITION FOR AMENDMENT OF THE STATE AID DISTRIBUTION ACT.

To the Honorable the Legislative Council, in Parliament assembled.

The Petition of the Rev. Charles Simson, Presbyterian Minister, O'Brien's Bridge.

## HUMBLY SHOWETH:

THAT your Petitioner has been declared a Trustee under the State Aid Distribution Act, and made personally responsible for the payment of the salary of one of the persons named in the Schedule annexed to the said Act.

That your Petitioner would most humbly represent to your Honorable Council the hardship and injustice of being held personally liable for the continuous payment of salary to an individual over whom he has not the slightest control,—such liability having been forced upon him without either his knowledge or consent.

That your Petitioner therefore prays that the State Aid Distribution Act may be amended so as to relieve your Petitioner from any liability or disability other than existed before the said State Aid Distribution Act was passed.

And your Petitioner will ever pray.
