WASTE LANDS ACT, 1863.

THE Governor in Council has been pleased to direct the publication of the following Regulations framed under the provisions of the 87th Section of "The Waste Lands Act, 1863," to supersede those published in the *Gazette* of the 24th January last:—

Whereas it is, amongst other things, provided by "The Waste Lands Act, 1863," that one-fourth part of all moneys which may be received after the first day of January, 1864, for or on account of purchase-money, rent, or licence-fees payable in respect of Waste Lands of the Crown, shall be set apart and form a fund for the construction of roads, bridges, tramways, jetties, and wharves; it is hereby directed that,—

1. In every Municipal and Police District there shall be annually appointed by the Governor in Council, from the Residents or Owners of Land in such District, a local honorary Board or Boards of Works consisting of not less than three Members: Provided, however, that if it shall be found in any District three competent persons cannot be found willing to act upon such Board, then in such case it shall be lawful for the Governor in Council to appoint fit and proper persons to be the Board for such District, notwithstanding that they or any of them may not be Residents, Owners, or Occupiers of property within such District; and provided further, that if in any Municipality there shall be no Councillor willing to act upon such Board, then it shall be lawful for the Governor in Council to appoint some other fit and competent person to act upon such Board, preference being given to a Resident or Owner of property within the District.

2. The Members of every Board shall appoint a Chairman, who shall frank all letters upon Public Service only connected with the duties of his Office as Chairman of the Board, and shall be provided with all requisite stationery; but no member of any such Board shall receive any remuneration for his services.

3. Any two Members of a Board shall constitute a quorum when the Board consists of three Members only, but when the number of Members exceeds three then that number shall be required to constitute a quorum, and the acts of a majority shall be considered to be the acts of the Board.

4. Every Board shall, upon being furnished by the Colonial Treasurer with a statement of the amount of money at the disposal of the Government for expenditure within the District upon roads, bridges, jetties, or tramways, within a reasonable time, report to the Governor in Council upon the best manner of expending the same so as to secure for each District an increase of the facilities of communication between Townships, or between Townships and the sea or some navigable river, or with the Main Road.

5. Upon the receipt of such Report, the Governor in Council shall either assent to or dissent from the recommendations of such Report. In case of dissent, the Governor in Council shall furnish to the Board the reason of such dissent, and thereupon the Board shall furnish a fresh Report containing other recommendations; and in case the Governor in Council shall decline to accept the recommendations contained in any such Report, such Report, together with the reason of the Governor in Council, shall be laid upon the Tables of both Houses of Parliament, and the sum of money disposable within such District shall be disposed of in such manner as by Resolution of both Houses of Parliament shall be directed.

6. Upon the assent of the Governor in Council being given to any of the recommendations contained in any Report being signified to the Board, tenders for the construction of the works recommended shall be invited by advertisement in the *Hobart Town Gazette* and some local newspaper.

7. Every specification shall (if required by the Board) be prepared in the office of the Director of Public Works; and every such Contract, together with the bond condition for the due performance of such Contract, shall be prepared in the office of the Solicitor-General.

8. All advertisements to be inserted in any newspaper shall be inserted as Government advertisements in a newspaper which, for the time being, shall hold the Government Contract for advertisements.
