



The survey of a line of road to connect that laid out by Mr. Dooley between Table Cape and Circular Head with the Bridge over the Detention River, as well as a deviation between 8th and 10th miles, has also been made; and the Tender of Messrs. Brown, Swain, and Lennard has been accepted for clearing the same, a distance of about $6\frac{1}{2}$ miles, at £78 per mile.

A Contract has also been entered into with Mr. C. B. M. Fenton for works on road between the Inglis Bridge and Jacob's Boat Harbour at £159, and for such of the under-mentioned works as may be ordered at the prices stated to the extent of the balance available on foot of vote:—

ROAD FROM ULVERSTONE TO GUNN'S PLAINS (CASTRA).

VOTE-£8000.

After the work of laying out the road to Gunn's Plains already reported upon had been completed, Tenders were invited for clearing and grubbing on the East Castra Line, commencing at the 11th mile peg and extending 5 miles 22 chains as marked into land of Mr. J. A. Fulton, together with branches from the same to the east boundary of land belonging to Mr. W. H. Blowers; and for like work West Castra commencing at the Old Gawler Road and extending to Colonel Fulton's north side line, a distance of 10 miles and 2 chains, and from thence to Major A. Dumbleton's south boundary, a distance of 4 miles.

The Tenders of William Andrews, being the lowest, at £520 and £767, were accepted, and the works are progressing.

Tenders were also invited in May last for clearing and grubbing on branch road, West Castra, commencing at the 5th mile-peg and terminating 77 chains beyond the 12th mile-peg, a distance of 7 miles and 77 chains.

That of William Andrews, at £115 per mile, being the lowest, was accepted for clearing, grubbing, and other works on road to a width of 20 feet, and for cutting down all trees and scrub and other work as per specification to a width of 23 feet on each side of the 20 feet. Works progressing.

There has been erected over the River Gawler, West Castra, under Contract of Joseph Raymond, a Trussed and Corbel Bridge in one span on log abutments. Entire length, 61 feet; clear width, 14 feet; height above highest flood level, 5 feet; with protecting railing and approaches, at a cost of £313 10s.

Four instalments (£400) on account of clearings East and West Castra have been charged against balance of the vote of £8000. To meet further outlay on works a sum of £2500 has been authorised by the Governor in Council to be provided under 18th Section of "The Waste Lands Act," 34 Vict. No. 10.

SORELL CAUSEWAY.

Under Acts 29 Vict. No. 1, and 33 Vict. No. 17.

The works at the Sorell Causeway have been carried on during the past year, and are still being proceeded with under Messrs. Oldham and Helmer's contract.

The road approach and the embankment from the Bluff towards Medway Point were commenced in February last, and considerable progress has been made in carrying out the same. The excavation for the road is of very great depth through a hard sandstone,-an excellent material for forming the embankment.

The timber bridging to connect this embankment with Medway Point has also been proceeded with. The whole of the piles are driven, except those which remain in abeyance, pending decision as to the erection of a draw-bridge. About one-third of the remainder of the timber work on this section is completed.

On the road across Medway Point the slopes have been cut down, and materials obtained for the embankment to the Sorell shore.

The work to the embankments from Medway Point towards the Sorell shore (formed, but not finished under previous contracts) has consisted only of dressing the slopes and making the embankments the full width.

The timber bridging on this section is nearly completed; a few rails to the fences, and braces to the piles, only being required.

The embankment from the timber bridging to the Sorell shore has been lately commenced; but as yet little progress has been made thereon.

Messrs. Oldham and Helmer expect to complete their contract by 25th July, 1872.
