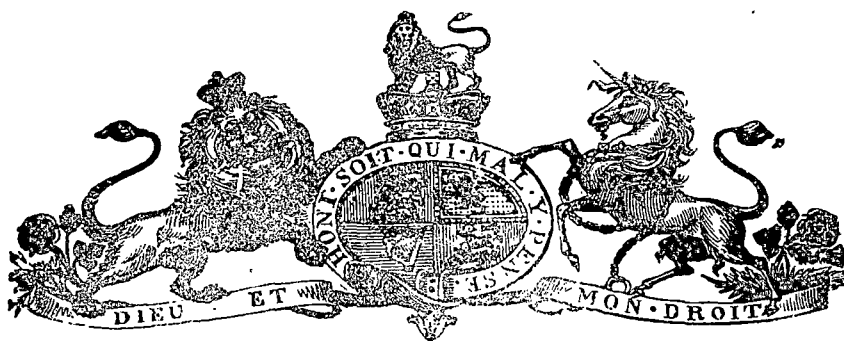

in Parliament assembled.*

THAT the proposal to make a Quarantine Station upon the said Island is opposed to our wishes, inasmuch as those persons who have been in contact with the infected ones at the Quarantine Ground would be liable to get away and carry disease to ourselves, and no amount of care could prevent them so escaping. Therefore your Petitioners humbly pray that some other place be selected for a Quarantine Station.
