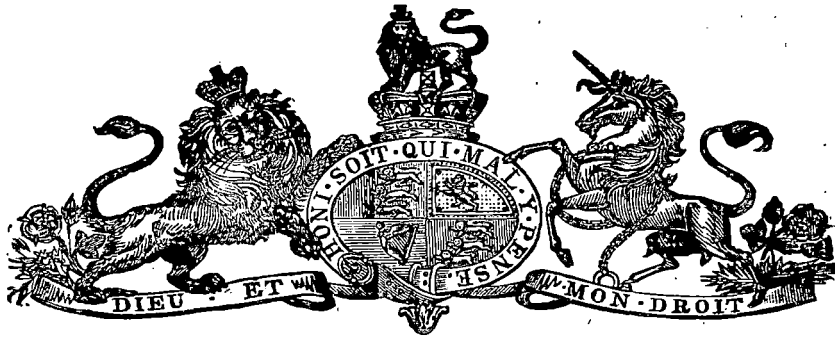

Crown Lands Office, 1st November, 1889.

THE Governor in Council has approved of the following Regulations under the provisions of "The Waste Lands Act, 1870," 34 Victoria, No. 10, and "The Waste Lands Act, 1881," 45 Victoria, No. 5: to take effect from and after 1st November, 1889, and to supersede the Regulation No. 2 made by His Excellency the Governor, and dated 26th September, 1887.

REGULATIONS FOR STRIPPING WATTLE BARK.

1. Lessees of Crown Lands under "The Waste Lands Act" may be allowed to strip Wattle Bark on the lands leased by them, provided that the value of the bark is ascertained by the Bailiff of Crown Lands, or any other Officer deputed to report on the same by the Conservator of Forests, and that such amount is approved by the Minister of Lands.

2. All unoccupied Crown Lands containing Wattles will be open to tender in lots of about 500 to 1000 acres; or lots may be sold by auction, at the option of the Minister of Lands, and at his discretion.
