



WATCH-HOUSES.

RETURN TO AN ORDER OF THE HOUSE; (Mr. Abbott, 13 Nov., 1861.)

Laid upon the Table by Mr. Innes, and ordered by the House to be printed, 22 January, 1862.



THE Sum of £3000 (provided by Loans Bill, 24 Vict., No. 38), for Watch-houses throughout the Territory, was voted by Parliament for the erection of Watch-houses and Police Buildings at the under-mentioned Places, in conformity with the Return furnished at the time to the Legislature.
