Crown Proceedings Amendment Bill 2016

The Crown Proceedings Amendment Bill 2016 makes amendments to the *Crown Proceedings Act 1993* to reflect the transfer of the Crown's civil litigation practice from the Office of the Director of Public Prosecutions to the Office of the Solicitor-General.

The Bill amends the *Crown Proceedings Act 1993* by:

- providing that service of a process or document in relation to proceedings on the State Crown is effected on the Solicitor-General;
- providing that service of subpoenas on Ministers is effected on the Solicitor-General; and
- making necessary savings and transitional provisions.
