Crime (Confiscation of Profits) Amendment (Unexplained Wealth) Bill 2013

The Bill amendments the Crime (Confiscation of Profits) Act 1993.

The Bill amends the *Crime (Confiscation of Profits) Act 1993* by inserting a new Part 9 containing provisions which -

- (i) enables the Supreme Court to make an unexplained wealth declaration against a person who apparently lives beyond their legitimate income, unless the person can establish that the wealth was lawfully acquired; and
- (ii) allows the Supreme Court to order payment by that person to the State of the amount assessed as being the value of the person's "unexplained wealth"; and
- (iii) provides associated powers of investigation, tracing, preservation of assets and other related matters.
