

CLAUSE NOTES

Statutory Appointments (Validation) Bill 2016

- Clause 1:** Short Title.
- Clause 2:** Commencement date.
- Clause 3:** Contains definitions of words and phrases used.
- Clause 4:** Provides that appointments and decisions are not invalid simply because the person appointed to make the decision did not hold a relevant practising certificate. Further, provides that a relevant body is not invalidly constituted and decisions of the body are not invalid simply because the person by whom the body was constituted did not hold a relevant practising certificate.
- Clause 5:** Provides the Act is to be administered by the Minister for Justice and the responsible department is the Department of Justice.
