REPORT.

THE Standing Committee on Public Accounts has the honour to submit the following Report to the favourable consideration of your Honourable House:—

NELSON'S LAGOON DRAINAGE LOAN.

This was an application for a loan of £2000 for the purpose of regrading Nelson's Lagoon, Flinders Island, and cutting two short spur drains to pick up two creeks and lead them to the main drain. After carefully considering the abovementioned application, your Committee decided to defer further consideration of the proposal with the view to obtaining a full report on this subject from an officer of the Lands Department.

MUNICIPALITY OF PENGUIN LOAN.

This was an application for a loan of Two hundred and fifty Pounds for the purpose of carrying out the objects of the Penguin Sewerage Act, 1913. After due consideration your Committee decided to recommend the granting of the loan.
