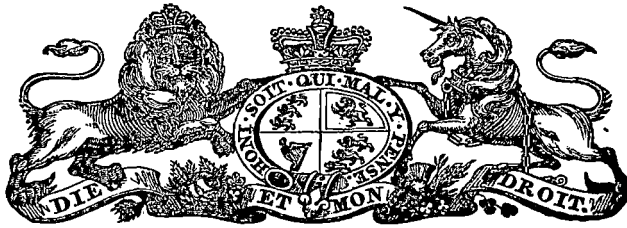

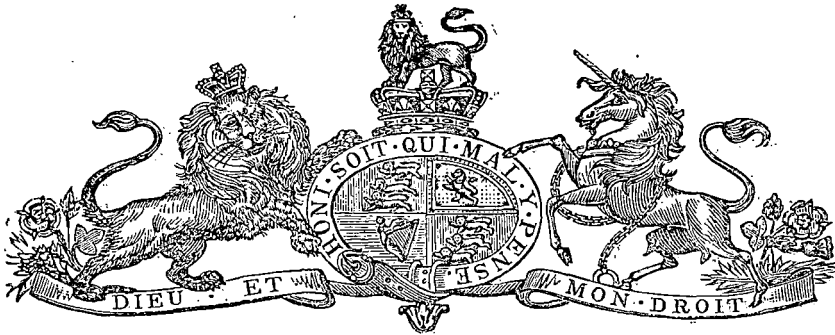

*TWELFTH Annual Report of the Mount Bischoff Provident Hospital, for Year ended 31st December, 1892.*

Waratah, 23rd January, 1893.

SIR,

THE Committee of the above Institution have much pleasure in submitting the Twelfth Annual Report and Balance Sheet.

*Buildings and Improvements.*—The buildings are in a thorough state of repair. A commodious wood-shed has been erected at a cost of £33 4s. 9d., capable of holding 100 tons of firewood. The wards have been fitted up with electric bells in connexion with Nurses' quarters, costing £10 14s. 4d., which will prove of great benefit to patients. Side fence has been put up at a cost of £9 17s. Tenders are also out for new batten fence fronting Hospital.

*Medical.*—During the year the Medical Officer, Dr. R. A. Brewis, has treated as outside patients 463 cases, viz., 192 males, 271 females, and 8 males and 1 female as in-door patients. No deaths during the year in the Institution. The Medical Officer giving every attention to patients, and working assiduously.

*Financial.*—The year has closed with a credit balance of £626 11s. 7d., against £578 5s. 6d. of last year. Rules and Regulations of Hospital have been revised, corrected, and added to, and circulated amongst subscribers.

Kayser, Esq., Manager of Mount Bischoff Company, from visitors to the mine, and generously handed over to the Committee; also the sum of £3 8s. 9d. from Collection Box in the office of the Mount Bischoff Company.

*Committee.*—The following changes have taken place in the *personnel*; viz., Mr. Anthony Roberts, in lieu of Mr. A. W. Lucas; Mr. James Stevens, in lieu of Mr. John Warburton, resigned. Mr. A. A. Littler was unanimously re-elected President, Mr. C. Sheedy Vice-President, Mr. George Dakin re-elected Treasurer.
