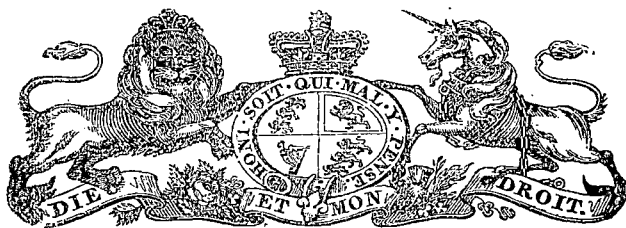

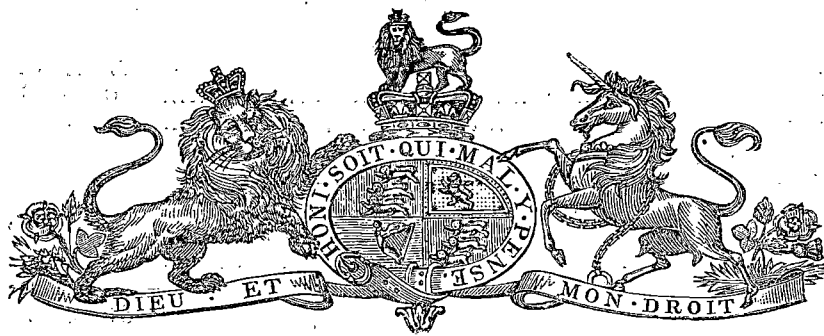

Average age, 23·75.

Education—17 could read and write ; 4 read only ; 8 could neither read nor write.

The daily average was 5·96, and the average period of detention 78 days.
