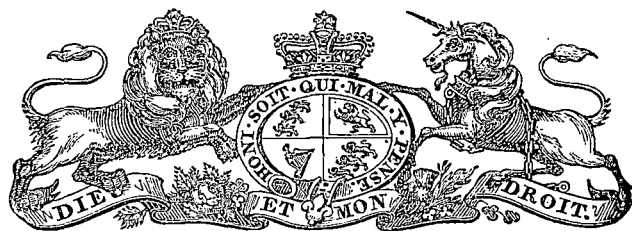

*ANNUAL REPORT of the TASMANIAN COUNCIL OF EDUCATION for the Year 1885-86.*

*To His Excellency SIR GEORGE CUMINE STRAHAN, Knight Commander of the Most Distinguished Order of St. Michael and St. George, Governor and Commander-in-Chief in and over the Colony of Tasmania and its Dependencies.*

MAY IT PLEASE YOUR EXCELLENCY.

1. In conformity with the provisions of "The Tasmanian Council of Education and Scholarship Act," we have the honor to submit this our Twenty-sixth Report of the proceedings of the Council from 1st May, 1885, to 30th April, 1886. 22<sup>nd</sup> Vict. No. 21, Section 30.

2. His Honor Mr. Justice Giblin was elected President for the year ending 30th June, 1886, but, to the regret of the Council, resigned the office on the 21st April, and the Rev. Canon Archer, M.A., was elected as his successor on the 28th of the same month for the period ending 30th June, 1887. President.

3. The Annual Examination of Candidates for the Council of Education Exhibitions was held in the month of June, 1885. Nine Candidates, of whom three were girls, presented themselves for examination; and, on the recommendation of the Examiners, Exhibitions of the value of £20 each for four years were awarded to the under-mentioned Candidates:—James Bellord Waldron, Church Grammar School, Launceston; Wilfred Hodgman, High School, Hobart; Francis Vincent Sullivan, St. Francis Xavier's School, Launceston; Mary Hogg, Mr. Hogg's Collegiate Institute, Launceston; Edith Rhoda Hurst, Ladies' College, Hobart. 4. The twenty-sixth examination for the Degree of Associate of Arts was held in December, 1885,—Alexander Leeper, Esq., LL.D., Principal of Trinity College, Melbourne, being Examiner in English, French, Latin, Greek, History, and Geography; T. J. Smith, Esq., M.A., also of Trinity College, Melbourne, Examiner in Pure Mathematics, Natural Philosophy, Chemistry, Zoology and Botany, and Geology; the Rev. Thomas Kelsh, Examiner in Italian; Henry Hunter, Esq., Examiner in Drawing; J. A. Jackson, Esq., B.A. Oxon., Examiner in German; and J. Summers, Esq., Examiner in Music. Eight Candidates under nineteen years of age presented themselves, and five succeeded in obtaining the Degree—three being placed in the First Class, one in the Second Class, and one in the Third Class. Degree of Associate of Arts, Gazette Notice, 13th Jan., 1885.

One Candidate over nineteen years of age who presented himself succeeded in gaining a Third Class Degree.

Frederick Grueber Thorne, as Senior Associate of the year, received the Council's Gold Medal; he also gained First Prize for Latin, First Prize for Greek, First Prize for French, First Prize for Italian, First Prize for Mathematics, Second Prize for English, and a Prize for Natural Philosophy. Prizes were also awarded to the under-mentioned Associates who were placed in the First Class, as follows:—Gustave Heuzé Hogg, First Prize for English, Second Prize for Latin, Second Prize for French, and a Prize for Chemistry; Charles Leslie Cutmear, Second Prize for Mathematics. In the Third Class, Maud Bestland Barnard, was awarded the Council's Silver Medal as Senior Female Associate of the year, a Prize for Zoology and Botany, and a Prize for Drawing.

Tasmanian Scholarships, Gazette Notice, 13th Jan., 1885.

5. The Examination for Tasmanian Scholarships took place in December last, and was conducted by Dr. Leeper and T. J. Smith, Esq., M.A., J. A. Jackson, Esq., B.A., taking the German. Three Candidates presented themselves; two,—Ralph Stuart Stephenson, A.A., 1882, and Edwin Arthur Lamprill, A.A., 1883,—reached the standard prescribed by the Council. A Scholarship was awarded to each of them, and they have since proceeded to Great Britain to enter upon their University studies.

The other Candidate—William Leslie Giblin, A.A., 1883,—came within the limits of eligibility for a Scholarship.

Progress of Tasmanian Scholars.

6. With regard to the progress of Tasmanian Scholars in Great Britain, we learn, from official certificates furnished to us, that Mr. John Warnock has taken the Degrees of M.B., C.M. and B.Sc. at Edinburgh, and has been admitted as M.R.C.S. of England. Mr. C. W. Rock took his B.A. Degree at Cambridge last June, graduating twenty-fourth Wrangler in the Mathematical Tripos. Mr. Frederick Lodge obtained his B.A. Degree in honours at Oxford. Mr. J. J. Macnamara has gained the third Entrance Medical Scholarship, valued at £40 per annum, at University College, London.

From information furnished us by parents and friends of Tasmanian Scholars, we learn that Mr. J. S. Clemons has passed his examination for the Degree of B.A. at Oxford, but the Degree has not yet been conferred upon him. He expects shortly to be called to the Bar from Lincoln's Inn. Mr. F. Lodge passed his first legal examination in January last. Mr. P. L. Waterhouse is working at Cambridge for his Law Tripos. Mr. W. H. Tofft intends, in July, to present himself for his second professional examination; he has taken during the last term three Certificates,—one, a First Class for Practical Anatomy, and two Second Class for *Materia Medica* and Physiology respectively. Mr. C. S. Dowdell passed, in April last, his examination for M.R.C.S., London. Mr. E. G. Allport is steadily pursuing his studies, and attending Professor Stuart's classes for the purpose of learning Engineering. In January last Mr. Macnamara passed the Preliminary Scientific M.B., gaining a First Class, and more recently his first examination in Anatomy and Physiology at the London College of Surgeons. Messrs. Smith and Hales have both entered Clare Cottage, Cambridge; each was placed in the First Class of the "Little-go" examination.

Minor Scholarships.

7. The two Minor Scholarships at the disposal of the Council for the year have been awarded to Frederick Grueber Thorne, and Gustave Heuzé Hogg, they having intimated their intention to study and compete for a Tasmanian Scholarship. These Scholarships are each of the value of £40 per annum, and are tenable for two years.

Dry Scholarship.

8. The Dry Scholarship was awarded to Frederick Grueber Thorne, Senior Associate of the year, he having announced his intention of studying for the Tasmanian Scholarship Examination.

Local Examination for

9. Since the publication of our last Report two examinations for Matriculation at the University of Melbourne have been held in Hobart under our supervision. The

Examination known as "end of February Term," began on the 20th May, 1885, three Candidates presented themselves; one of these Alexander M. Laren, succeeded in passing the Civil Service Examinations. For the "October Term" Examination, which was held in December, to which six, three male and three female Candidates, were admitted, Mr. Alfred Beighton Pitt, was the only one who succeeded in passing in sufficient subjects to matriculate. 10. The second examination for the Gilchrist Scholarship under the new conditions—*i.e.*, annual examination open to any of the Australian Colonies—was held in January, 1885. Since the publication of our last report we have learnt that Mr. Russell Wells Roberts, of Hobart, was the successful Candidate. Gilchrist

The third examination took place in January, 1886, at which two Candidates presented themselves, but we have not yet ascertained the result.

11. Vacancies were caused during the year by the retirement of the Rev. J. C. Whall, His Honor Mr. Justice Dobson, and the Right Rev. the Bishop of Tasmania, also by the decease of the Hon. Henry Butler. These vacancies have been filled by the election of H. Hunter, Esq., the Hon. J. W. Agnew, Dr. Perkins, and the Hon. A. Dobson. In recording the death of the Hon. Henry Butler, who had been a Member of this Council from its formation, we desire to express our regret at the loss we have sustained by his demise, and to place upon record our high appreciation of his services rendered not only to the Council but generally in the cause of Education in Tasmania. 12. We desire again to place on record our conviction of the importance of altering the constitution of the Council, and of creating a Tasmanian University. Proposed

13. We submit a Statement of the Disbursements of the Council between the 1st January and the 31st December, 1885, the termination of the financial year, together with a Supplementary Statement of payments between the 1st January and the 30th April, 1886. The total expenditure under every head for the year 1885 is shown to have amounted to £2790 4s. 6d. Financial  
Statement.

14. We append to our Report a Roll of the Tasmanian Scholars, a List of those students who have obtained the Degree of Associate of Arts, and a List of those who obtained Exhibitions offered by the Council. Appendices
