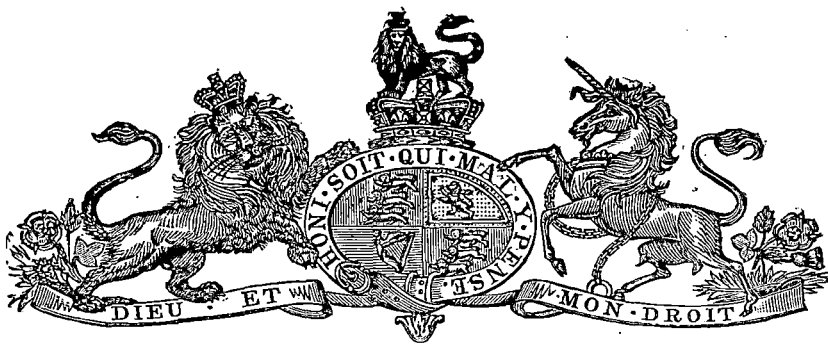

COMMISSIONER'S REPORT FOR 1893.

Presented to both Houses of Parliament by His Excellency's Command.



Office of Taxes, Hobart, 16th February, 1894.

SIR,

I HAVE the honor to submit the following Returns, Nos. 1 to 7, explanatory of the work of this Department for the year 1893 :—

1. Return showing the number of items subject to Real Estate Duty and Land Tax, and the rateable and capital values of the properties in each District for the years 1888, 1889, 1890, 1891, 1892, and 1893.
2. Return showing the number of items subject to Land Tax, and amount of Land Tax for each District for the year 1891; the amount collected, and remaining due, on the 31st December, 1893.
3. Return showing the number of items subject to Land Tax, the amount of Land Tax for each District for the year 1892; the amount collected, and remaining due, on the 31st December, 1893.
4. Return showing the number of items subject to Land Tax, and amount of Land Tax, for each District for the year 1893; the amount collected, and remaining due, on the 31st December, 1893.
5. Return showing the number of items, and amount of Rural Police Rate for each District for the year 1891; the amount collected, and remaining due, on the 31st December, 1893.
6. Return showing the number of items and amount of Rural Police Rate for each District for the year 1892; the amount collected, and remaining due, on the 31st December, 1893.
7. Return showing the number of items and amount of Rural Police Rate for each District for the year 1893; the amount collected, and remaining due, on the 31st December, 1893.

Return No. 1 shows a slight increase in the number of properties, but a decrease in capital value of £91,073, due to the re-assessments caused by the general shrinkage in the value of property, and the fact that the sales of property during 1893 were generally below their assessed value, due to the same cause; but if a deduction is made for the assessed value of the Main Line Railway (£600,000) purchased by the Government in 1891, and erased from the Assessment Book, the capital value of properties in 1893 is £566,026 more than in 1889, and the number of properties assessed is 2714 more.

The Accounts for 1891 will now be closed, as nearly all the recoverable items have been collected. All the uncollected items of Land Tax and Rural Police Rate for 1892 were given to the Crown Solicitor for collection previous to the date of my last Report, but owing to the continued depression the proportion of uncollected items for that year is slightly in excess of that for 1891 on the 22nd May last year.

Return No. 4 shows a larger amount of Land Tax uncollected as compared with former years. This is entirely due to the late date on which the Department was able to send out the demands. Of the uncollected amount the sum of £7700 has been collected since the 31st December, so that, taking into account the late date on which the demands were issued, the tax has been as promptly paid as in any previous year.

The comparatively large amount of Police Rate still shown as due for 1892 is owing to the shifting population in the District of Macquarie, and the number of Mineral Leases that have been forfeited.

As a result of the continued depression and shrinkage in the value of property, a larger number of applications have been received for the re-assessment of properties than were made last year, and I anticipate a considerable decrease in the capital value of properties for the year 1894 from this and other causes.

Besides the usual routine work of the Department, a large amount of work has been done in obtaining information in relation to the Taxation proposals. This, coupled with the late date at which it was determined to adhere to the Land Tax of 1889, caused some extra expense for clerical assistance.
