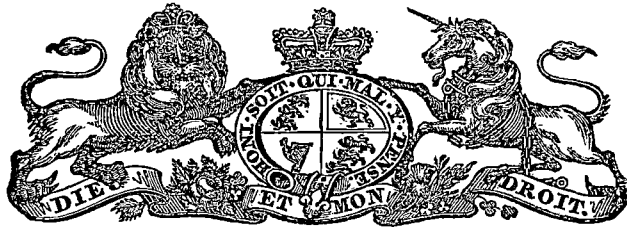

YOUR Committee have the honor to report that they have gone through the Bill remitted to their consideration, and have made the amendments in the Fifth Clause shown in the copy of the Bill hereto annexed.

*Clause 5 as amended.*

5 Any such application as aforesaid shall be by notice in writing under the hand of the applicant or applicants, and shall be served on the owner or owners through whose lands such new drains or improvements are intended to be taken, and on the occupier or occupiers of such lands if the owner is not the occupier, and also on the owners and occupiers whose lands may be interfered with or affected by such drains. The notice shall state the nature of such drains or improvements in drains, and the names of the owners and occupiers whose lands will be cut through, interfered with, or affected by such drains or improvements, and shall be accompanied by a map, on which the length, width, and depth of the proposed drains or improvements in drains shall be delineated, and shall further state the compensation, if any, which the applicant or applicants proposes or propose to pay.
