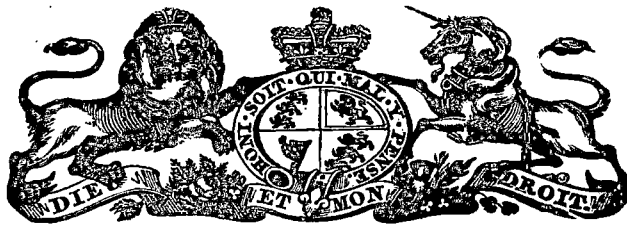

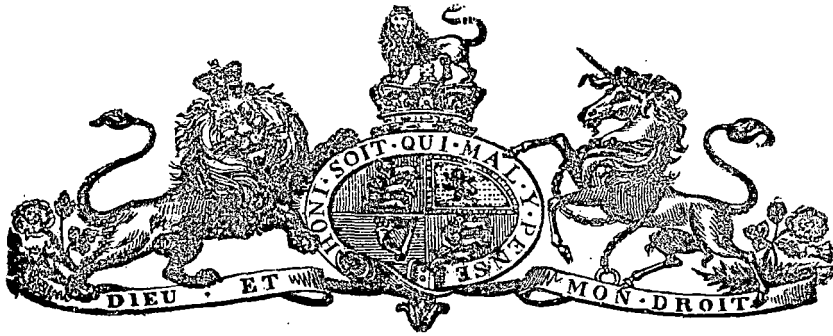

PARLIAMENTARY LIBRARY:

REPORT FOR 1880.

Laid upon the Table by the Colonial Treasurer, and ordered by the House to be printed, July 19, 1881.



Library of Parliament, 1st July, 1881.

SIR,

IN presenting my Report for the Session on the Parliamentary Library, in accordance with the Rules, I desire to say that I have personally gone over all the Books in their several rooms, and find them in good order, requiring very little attention from the bookbinder.

A large number of books has been added to the Library since my last Report on 20th September, 1880, of which 65 have been purchased through Messrs. Walch and Sons, 19 have been presented by the Smithsonian Institution, 107 by the Belgian Consul-General in Melbourne—Mr. Gustave Beckx—and 5 from other gentlemen.

The number of volumes now in the Parliamentary Library, inclusive of Magazines and large Pamphlets, is 8800 volumes, which are insured against fire for £2000 in the Derwent and Tamar Assurance Company.

Two boxes of Patent Specifications, in bound volumes, have been received from the Patent Office in London, and placed with the others.

A large number of Books published by the British Parliament has also been received, and placed in the Library.

Efforts have been made to recover Books which have been missing, some of them for many years; and since last Report 14 volumes have been returned by those who have irregularly taken them out. The number of missing Books, however, is still very large.

I annex the usual Annual Return of Books purchased or presented, and missing, at this date.
