SIR,

I HAVE the honor to forward for your information the following particulars with reference to the work of the Department for the Year ending 31st May, 1896.

The total expenditure for the year has been £80,063 19s. 10d., made up as follows:—

The works have been principally of an ordinary character, contracts generally being for small amounts—the chief exceptions being Tamar Bridge, Launceston; Boys' Training School, New Town; Deviation Main Road, near Circular Head; Postmaster's Residence, Zeehan; Deep-water Jetty at Port Cygnet; School and Teacher's Residence, Kellevie.

Tamar Bridge.—The only work of an exceptional character undertaken during the year has been the Tamar Bridge, for which tenders were invited under date 17th June, in accordance with the plans prepared by the late Engineer-in-Chief, and that of Messrs. Bogle and Clark, at £9196 13s. 6d., being the lowest out of five tenders received, was accepted. In accordance with strong representations by the Municipal Council, certain alterations will be made by the substitution of iron-plate decking, for which a subsequent arrangement has been made with contractors. It is considered, however, that with some probable savings which may be effected in other directions, the total cost of the work will not exceed the amount available, and it is to be completed in eighteen months.

The works on Roads and Bridges have been supervised by the two Divisional Inspectors, Mr. J. Helmer in the South, and Mr. G. Simmons in the North, assisted by local inspectors. It has been necessary, in affording relief works for unemployed, to carry out a large portion of the road works by day labour under capable overseers. The maximum rate of wages hitherto paid has been continued, viz., Four shillings per day, except at the West Coast where it has been Five shillings. The total amount expended during the year in this respect has been £16,164, and the particulars of works so carried out are given in Table D, attached hereto.

The works in connection with the erection of new buildings, and the repair and alteration of others, have been carried out under the supervision of the Inspector of Public Buildings, Mr. J. G. Shield, assisted by Clerk of Works, Hobart, Clerk of Works, Zeehan, and occasional local clerks of works when required.

The following works have been undertaken during the year:—

New State School and Teachers' Residences, Kellevie and Stowport; new School at Beulah; Schools and residences (now in progress) at Bream Creek, Antill Ponds, and West Tamar; and new residence at Glengarry. Alterations, additions, and repairs at following Schools:—Mathinna, Woodsdale, Young Town, Nugent, Forest, Cleveland, Nook, Hamilton, New Town; and Central, Goulburn-street, Battery Point, Murray-street, and Trinity Hill Schools, Hobart. Additions and alterations, Post and Telegraph Offices throughout the Colony. New Police

Buildings, Volunteer, and sundry repairs to Police Buildings generally. Accommodation Houses for Tourists, Lake St. Clair and Hartz Mountains. Extensive alterations at Public Buildings, Murray and Macquarie streets, to provide additional accommodation for Audit Department, and to afford further space for Post and Telegraph Departments; alterations at old Telegraph Office for Taxes Department; sundry repairs at Government House and Public Buildings, and Institutions generally.

The Boys' Training School, New Town, has been satisfactorily completed during the year, including a new residence for the Teacher connected with the school; also the new State School, Upper Macquarie-street. Plans and specifications have also been prepared for new school and residence, Brighton and Eastwood, and new class-room, Strahan. Plans and specifications have also been prepared for additional rooms to residence for Governor of Gaol, Hobart; also for new roofs to large workshops at the Gaol; these and other works are to be carried out by prison labour under the supervision of this Department. Plans and specifications have also been prepared, and contracts entered into, for the following works:—Postmaster's residence and alterations to Post Office, Zeehan; alterations to Police Buildings, Liverpool-street, to provide additional accommodation for Police; alterations to old School, Zeehan, to render same suitable for Police Buildings.

Dredging works at River Mersey have been carried out during the year under the Marine Board, and the amount paid to the Board this year has been £3201 0s. 6d.

Crown Lands Acts.

The expenditure under the Crown Lands Acts has been continued in the usual way, the amount expended being £11,371 8s.

Table C. attached gives particulars of expenditure under these Acts, from which it will be seen that in nineteen cases the funds have been exceeded by a total of £5129 3s., owing to forfeiture of selections. These excesses were referred to in last Return; but have only been reduced by additional selections during the year to the extent of £173 17s.
