

Note.—158,640 ova and fry of Salmon Trout and Brown Trout have been produced at the Salmon Ponds, of which number 41,350 ova were presented to Victoria and New Zealand, and 800 to Western Australia. 38,000 ova have been purchased in New South Wales, Victoria, and South Australia, and 78,490 ova and fry have been issued for distribution throughout Tasmania.
