

HOSPITAL FOR THE INSANE, CASCADES.

To His Excellency Sir George Cumine Strahan, Knight Commander of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George, Governor and Commander-in-Chief in and over the Colony of Tasmania and its Dependencies.

MAY IT PLEASE YOUR EXCELLENCY.

IT is our duty to submit the Fourth Annual Report on this Institution, being that for the year 1881.

- 2. The number of patients remaining on the 31st December, 1881, was 68, who, with one exception, were received from Port Arthur.
 - 3. Their average age is $61\frac{1}{2}$ years, the eldest being 85 and the youngest 36 years of age.
 - 4. Four deaths occurred during the year.
- 5. The health of the patients has been fairly good; but in no instance has there been any improvement in their mental condition.
- 6. The net expenditure for the year 1881 was £2133 1s. 3d., of which £1984 is contributed by the Imperial Government, leaving £149 1s. 3d. to be defrayed by the Colonial Government.
- 7. The various Officers of the Hospital have performed their duties satisfactorily; and on our monthly visits we have had evidence of their assiduity, and the gentle and considerate treatment of those under their charge.
- 8. The Superintendent continues to have medical charge of the patients in the Lock Hospital; and during the last nine months of the year advantage has been taken of the vacant space in these buildings to accommodate about twenty of the female invalids from the New Town Charitable Institution, who are also under his treatment.
 - 9. The customary Returns of Deaths, Expenditure, Reimbursements, &c. are appended.
