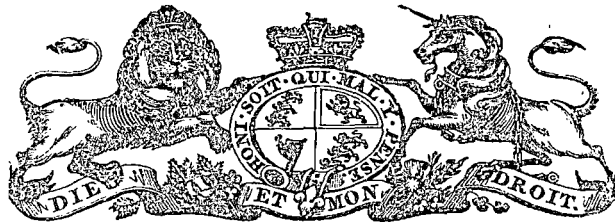

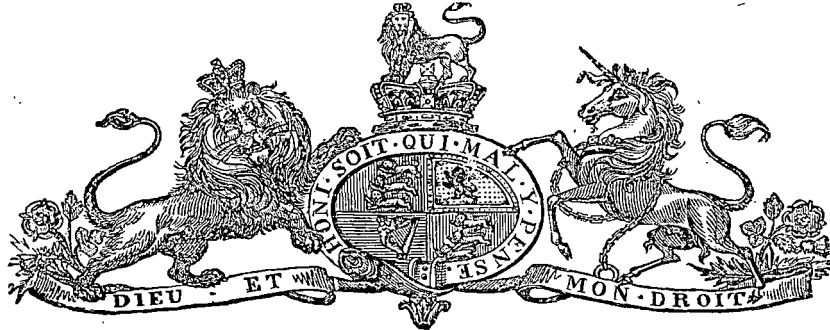

RETURN TO AN ORDER OF THE HOUSE.

(Mr. Sharland, 20 August, 1862.)

Laid upon the Table by the Colonial Treasurer, and ordered by the House to be printed, 28 August, 1862.



RETURN of all TOWNSHIPS that have been established throughout the Colony since the passing of "The Waste Lands Act," with the Name of the Surveyor or Person recommending the same, the Time of such Recommendation, and the Name of any Surveyor having Land adjoining such Townships.
