

SIR, THE Trustees of the Tasmanian Public Library, in compliance with Clause 7 of the Act to provide for the Incorporation and Government of that Institution (34 Vict. No. 27), beg to submit the following Report of its working during the year 1878.

REPORT.

1. THE Trustees, in presenting their Eighth annual Report, have pleasure in announcing that during the past twelve months 31,055 visits have been recorded in the Visitors' Book; the numbers showing an increase as compared with any previous year.

2. The experiment of opening the Institution on all public holidays, and on the afternoons of Sunday, Good Friday, and Christmas Day, has been tried from the 1st day of June last with most satisfactory results, and appears to be highly appreciated by the public. The Trustees feel that in making this alteration they have met the wishes of a large section of the community who previously had little or no opportunity to avail themselves of the privileges and advantages afforded by an Institution which they are taxed to support.

3. The Trustees have to acknowledge with thanks presentations from kindred Institutions in England, Ireland, New South Wales, Victoria, South Australia, New Zealand, Tasmania, and from the Governments of the various colonies.

4. During the year 216 volumes have been added to the Library by purchase and presentation.

5. In addition to the valuable collection of works of reference and general literature on the shelves, the following Reviews, Magazines, and Newspapers are to be found upon the Reading-room tables :---

9. The Books, Furniture, and Fittings belonging to the Public Library are insured in the Cornwall Insurance Company for $\pounds 2000$.

10. The invested funds amount to one thousand five hundred pounds placed in the Commercial Bank as a fixed deposit for one year, bearing interest at the rate of 6 per cent. Out of the revenue so derived a sum of seventy-five pounds is paid over by the Trustees of the Library to the Municipal Council of Hobart Town in aid of the salary of the Librarian. 5
