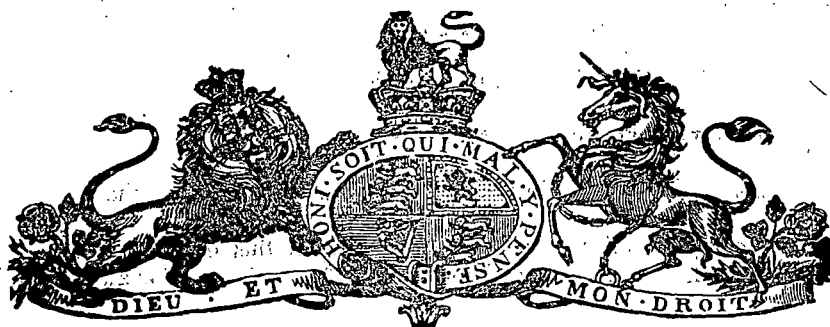

### REPORT OF EXAMINERS.

*Hobart, 30th June, 1890.*

THE Examiners present their Report on the Annual Examination for Exhibitions from State Schools, which was held at Hobart and Launceston on the 24th, 25th, and 26th inst.

Twenty-nine candidates were examined—twenty-five boys and four girls.

*Reading.*—The reading of the majority of the candidates was very satisfactory in respect to correctness, clearness, and fluency. Several read with good expression.

*Writing and Spelling from Dictation.*—The penmanship was generally neat and clear, the spelling very good in a few cases, fair on the whole.

*Arithmetic.*—The average results in this subject were moderate, though several did fairly well and one excellently.

*Grammar.*—The average number of marks obtained was slightly under that of last year; but a larger proportion of the candidates obtained good marks.

*Geography.*—In this subject the answering of the majority was not satisfactory.

*History.*—The work shown up in History was moderate.

*General Questions.*—The answering to these questions was, on the whole, very fair.

It is very satisfactory to notice in the general results of this examination that, out of twenty-nine candidates examined, fifteen reached the standard of qualification for an Exhibition.
