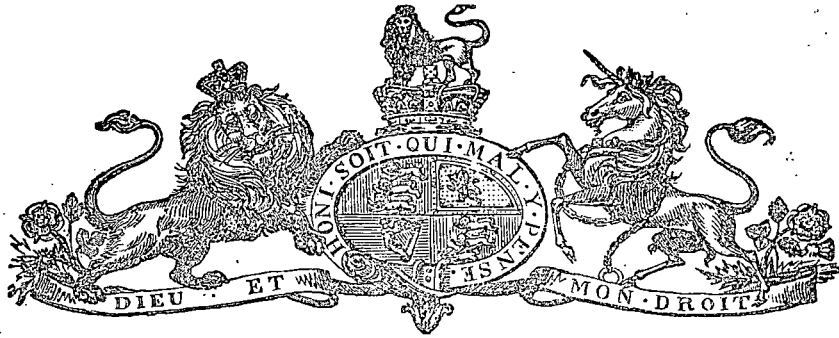

*Parliamentary Library, 20th September, 1880.*

SIR,

I HAVE the honor to forward my Annual Report on the state of the Parliamentary Library, which is required by Rule 11.

2. The number of volumes in the Library at this date is, besides Pamphlets and Magazines, 8500, of which 106 have been added by purchase or presentation during the year.

3. Two boxes of Patent Specifications have recently been received. These are now bound in volumes in England, and save me much trouble in their arrangement. The value of the gift by the Patent Office in England of the Specifications of Patents for the last 200 years is said to be about £2000. They are placed here in a very inconvenient position in a Vault; and, during the recess, I had several applications for references to Patents, which took up much time, owing to the distance of the Vault from my Rooms.

4. Another box of Books has also arrived as a present from the Smithsonian Institution in America. These have been arranged in what I term "the American Room," owing to all the Books presented from America being placed therein. A list of these Books recently received is annexed to this Report.

5. During the Recess I have prepared an Official Catalogue of all the Books in the Library, with the prices paid for each, which will be useful for reference in all future time.

6. I have also prepared for the press a Classified Alphabetical Catalogue of the nine thousand volumes of Books and Pamphlets brought down to date.

7. The usual Annual Returns are annexed to this Report; viz.—

I wish to renew my representation of the impossibility of classifying the Books in the eight small rooms in which they are placed. I have tried to do it during the 23 years I have had the honor to be Librarian, without effect.
