

THE following additional Regulations, made by His Excellency the Governor in Council under the authority of "The Gold Fields Regulation Act, 1880," to take effect forthwith, are published, in compliance with Section 63 of such Act (44 Vict. No. 16).

By virtue of *The Gold Fields Regulation Act*, 1880, His Excellency the Governor in Council doth make the additional Regulations following, which shall apply to that portion of the Colony bounded as follows:—

Commencing at the mouth of the River Blyth, and bounded by that river to the north boundary of the Surrey Hills Block, by that boundary to the north-east angle of that block, by the east boundary of that block, thence by a southerly line to the River Gordon crossing the Frenchman's Cap, thence by a westerly line to the sea near to and south of Point Hibbs, and thence by the sea northerly and easterly to the point of commencement.

121. Where it is intended to apply for a lease of any landsuch land shall be marked off, as nearly as may be practicable, in the form of a square, and the survey may be made in accordance with the marking off, anything in Regulation 75 to the contrary notwithstanding. This Regulation shall apply to land marked off, and to land marked off and applied for, before this Regulation takes effect.

122. The following scale shall be the scale of Survey Fees to be charged for the survey of densely-wooded or scrub land:—
