REPORT of the CAMPBELL TOWN HOSPITAL, 1881.

Campbell Town, 31st January, 1882.

Sir,

I HAVE the honor to forward the Annual Report of the Campbell Town Hospital for 1881.

In presenting their Report and Balance sheet for 1881 to the subscribers, the Trustees do so with the satisfactory assurance that the Campbell Town Hospital continues to be in a flourishing condition.

- 2. The system of dieting the Patients has now been tried for a period of two years; and although financially its success is self-evident, there may be room for improvement in the direction of a some what more generous diet, which we propose, therefore, shortly to introduce.
- 3. The reconsideration and amendment of Rule 8 would appear to be necessary, as the term "one admission" is not generally understood.
- 4. Number of cases treated, 37; of which 2 have died, 2 remained for treatment, the remainder were discharged.
- 5. The thanks of the Trustees are due to the Clergy for their kind ministrations to the sick. The Minister of Kirklands and Esk Vale has suggested that the idea of a "Hospital Sunday" be again considered. Mr. and Mrs. Raiker continue to give unqualified satisfaction.
