A BILL FOR

An Act to amend the *Long Service Leave Act 1976*

Be it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:

1. Short title

This Act may be cited as the *Long Service Leave Amendment Act 2008*.

2. Commencement

This Act commences on the day on which this Act receives the Royal Assent.

3. Principal Act

In this Act, the *Long Service Leave Act 1976** is referred to as the Principal Act.
