## IRRIGATION COMPANY (CONSEQUENTIAL AMENDMENTS) BILL 2011

## SECOND READING SPEECH

Mr Speaker, I move that the Bill be now read a second time.

The Irrigation Company (Consequential Amendments) Bill 2011 makes a number of amendments to relevant Tasmanian legislation which are required as a result of the enactment of the Irrigation Company Bill 2011.

A number of pieces of legislation in Tasmania make reference to the Rivers and Water Supply Commission, which will cease to exist on the day on which the Rivers and Water Supply Commission Act 1999 is repealed.

Predominately, the amendments involve substituting the name of the Rivers and Water Supply Commission in various Acts with the name of the new single State-owned company, to be known as Tasmanian Irrigation Pty Ltd.

Mr Speaker, I move the second reading of this Bill and commend the Bill to the House.
