The Parliamentary Standing Committee of Public Accounts has resolved to draft and table an interim report as soon as possible related to the Inquiry's existing Terms of Reference and evidence received to date.

The Committee further resolved to review and amend the current Terms of Reference to capture the changing environment and information available with regard to the Club Funding and Development Agreement and other matters associated with the proposed Arts, Entertainment and Sports Precinct at Macquarie Point. The revised Terms of Reference will be published as soon as finalised by the Committee.
