REPORT.

THE Standing Committee on Public Accounts has the honour to submit the following Report:—

LEVEN MUNICIPAL COUNCIL LOAN.

This was an application for a loan of £7000 for the purpose of improving the water-supply of the Town of Ulverstone by laying a nine-inch main from the reservoir to Gawler Road Junction.

After carefully considering the application, your Committee decided to recommend the granting of the loan. Your Committee desires to intimate that it is quite obvious, after investigation, that the Council will find it necessary to substantially increase its revenue to meet its added financial responsibility.

KINGBOROUGH MUNICIPAL COUNCIL LOAN.

This was an application for a loan of £3400 for lighting portion of the Municipality of Kingborough. Your Committee resolved to recommend the granting of the said loan.
