Summary of returns per calendar year for Property Protection Permits by species.

Property Protection Permits for Bennett's and rufous wallaby and brushtail possum are for five years. Prior to 2020, each year the Department of Natural Resources and Environment Tasmania selected 15 percent of permit holders to submit take returns. Commencing in 2020 as permits began expiring, permit holders were required to provide annual returns for these permits. Re-issued permits now require an annual return to be provided each year.

Note: 2024 returns are still being received and the NRE Tas does not have a full calendar year of data. Most people only provide this data when their permit falls due for renewal. Permits are only renewed for holders that provide return data.
