Future Works – Parliamentary Budget Office and Auditor-General Independence

The Parliamentary Standing Committee of Public Accounts (Committee) welcomes the views stated in Saul Eslake's *Independent Review of Tasmania's State Finances* report with respect to the establishment of a Parliamentary Budget Office (PBO) and enhancing the independence of the Tasmanian Audit Office.¹

The Committee resolved in July 2024 to inquire into feasibility of establishing a PBO in the Tasmanian jurisdiction and is currently considering the timing and terms of reference within its plan of work.

In line with the Committee's Statement of Understanding between itself and the Auditor-General, the Committee is in the process of considering how best to approach the issue of the Tasmanian Audit Office's independence. This will include how it may be brought into line with best practice in other jurisdictions and what amendments to the *Audit Act 2008* may be required.
