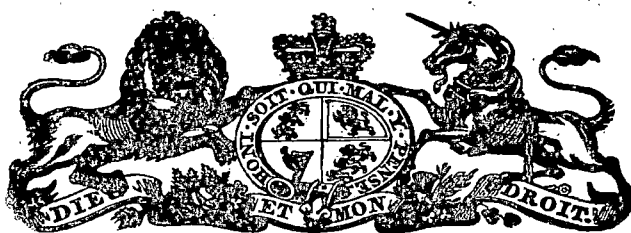

The humble Petition of the undersigned Landholders residing at the Upper Piper and Turner's Marsh,

RESPECTFULLY SHOWETH:

1. That your Petitioners are desirous that the Launceston and Scottsdale Railway Route, as surveyed by Mr. William Prior Hales, C.E., should be adopted.

2. That the said route, if adopted, would be the shortest and cheapest, and the largest population and area of land would be benefited thereby.

3. That the largest area of Crown land and of the best quality would be opened up and available for alienation by the aforesaid route.

4. That, if the said route were adopted, the largest number of settlers would be benefited thereby.

Your Petitioners therefore humbly pray that the above-mentioned route may be adopted and passed as the route over which the said Railway shall be constructed.
