

SIR,

THE Trustees of the Tasmanian Public Library, in compliance with Clause 7 of the Act to provide for the incorporation and government of the Institution (34 Vict. No. 27), beg to submit the following Report of its working during the year 1893-4.

During the year 105 volumes have been added by purchase and presentation.\*

The attendance of visitors to the Institution has been much larger than for any previous year, viz., 43,857.

The many difficulties which the Trustees have had to work under in their endeavour to maintain the usefulness of the Institution during the past 24 years have been fully set forth in their Report for the year 1891–92.

Dr. T. C. Smart and C. J. Barclay, Esq., having resigned their positions as Trustees, Hon. A. Inglis-Clark was appointed by the Municipal Council of Hobart, and C. M. Tenison, Esq., by the Governor in Council, to the vacant seats on the Board, in accordance with the provisions of Act 34 Vict. No. 27.

The City Council has voted a sum of £456 11s. for Library purposes for the year 1894, the estimated expenditure being as follows:—
