



No receipts in excess of £50 are reckoned in the calculations. The deduction of 5s. 9½d. in the £ is made in every case. The calculation on the basis adopted came to £700 8s. 9d. The excess of 8s. 9d. was provided for by deducting one shilling from each of the under-mentioned Libraries, namely:—Campbell Town, Green Ponds, New Norfolk, Oatlands, Scottsdale Mechanics' Institute, Sorell, Stanley, and Waratah, and also 9d. from the Westbury Library.
