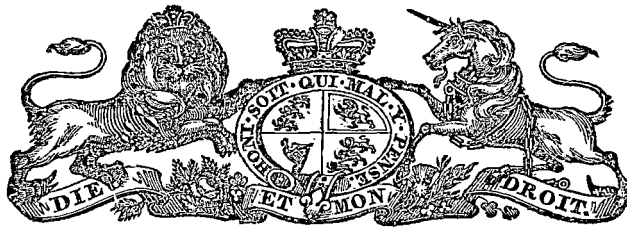

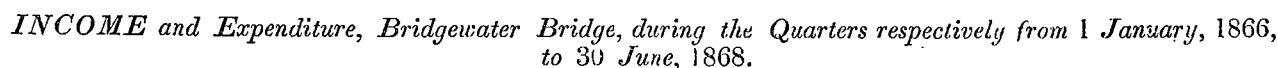
**BRIDGEWATER BRIDGE.**

Laid upon the Table by the Colonial Treasurer, and ordered by the House to be printed, August 21, 1868.



NOTE.—There was due by the Commissioners to the Bank of Van Diemen's Land on half-yearly rest to 30 June, 1866, the sum of £334 0s. 10½*d.* Reduced on 31 December, 1866, to £41 13s. 9½*d.*; and on 30 June, 1867, the Commissioners had to credit £358 2s. 1*d.*,—increased on 31 December to £516 15s. 3*d.*, and on 30 June, 1868, to £797 14s. 4*d.* Bridge opened for public traffic 30 April, 1849.
