



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## **MEMORANDUM** showing the proposed Expenditure by the Government for the future Maintenance of the Main Roads of the Colony.

As the cost of maintaining these Roads will be in proportion to the traffic, it is proposed they should be classified as per Schedules A. B. and C.

For the maintenance of the above Roads it is proposed there shall be appropriated annually a sum not exceeding Twenty-four Pounds ( $\pounds 24$ ) per mile.
