



R E P O R T.

THE Committee, having carefully considered the question remitted to them, recommend that, in consequence of William Beecroft having surrendered his Claim referred to in the Report of a former Committee of this House, under date 1st November, 1875, and his desire to allow the amount claimed (viz., £310) to be divided by the Select Committee appointed by this House between his Mother and her Children, the aforesaid amount of £310 be distributed as hereinafter mentioned; viz.—£100 to William Beecroft, and the balance (the Mother having already received £100) to be equally divided between herself and her other Children.
