

SIR, On the other side I beg leave to hand you the usual Annual Statement of the working of the Tasmania-Victoria Submarine Cable for 1878.

The revenue of the Line shows signs of progress; but the expenses are increased exceptionally by the cost of new heavy Shore Ends to the Cable, which were laid down for the purpose of preventing the frequent interruptions which took place by reason of the original Shore Ends having deteriorated. The cost of the new Shore Ends has been altogether  $\pounds 5610$  7s. 3d. We have decided to charge half this amount, in the Books of the Tasmanian Cable, against the revenue of the year 1878,—leaving the other moiety as a charge against the receipts of the current year.
