A Bill for

An Act to amend the *Anti-Discrimination Act 1998* by removing the exemption which allows discrimination on the basis of age in regard to both voluntary or compulsory retirement.

Be it enacted by his Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with their advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:

Short Title

1. This Act may be cited as the *Anti-Discrimination (Remove Age Limit) Amendment Act 2004*.

Commencement

2. This Act commences on the day on which it is proclaimed.

Principal Act

3. In this Act, the *Anti-Discrimination Act 1998* is referred to as the Principal Act.
