PUBLIC SECTOR SUPERANNUATION (MISCELLANEOUS AMENDMENTS) BILL 2013

The *Public Sector Superannuation (Miscellaneous Amendments) Bill 2013* makes changes to a number of pieces of superannuation legislation:

Firstly, it will amend the:

- *Public Sector Superannuation Reform Act 1999*;
- *Governor of Tasmania Act 1982*;
- *Solicitor General Act 1983*;
- *Director of Public Prosecutions Act 1973*;
- *Supreme Court Act 1887*;
- *Supreme Court Act 1959*; and
- *Parliamentary Salaries, Superannuation and Allowances Act 2012*;

so that public sector employer superannuation guarantee contribution rates for accumulation scheme members are aligned to the incremental increases prescribed under the *Superannuation Guarantee (Administration) Act 1992* of the Commonwealth, the first of which takes effect on 1 July 2013.

Secondly, Section 10(3) of the *Magistrates Court Act 1987*, which was inadvertently removed under the *Superannuation (Miscellaneous and Consequential Amendments) Act 2000*, will be reinstated with retrospective effect. This will remove any doubt that a Magistrate who was a member of the Contributory Scheme before it was closed, may remain in the Scheme.
