## PUBLIC SECTOR SUPERANNUATION (MISCELLANEOUS AMENDMENTS) BILL 2013

The Public Sector Superannuation (Miscellaneous Amendments) Bill 2013 makes changes to a number of pieces of superannuation legislation:

Firstly, it will amend the:

- Public Sector Superannuation Reform Act 1999;
- Governor of Tasmania Act 1982;
- Solicitor General Act 1983;
- Director of Public Prosecutions Act 1973;
- Supreme Court Act 1887;
- Supreme Court Act 1959; and
- Parliamentary Salaries, Superannuation and Allowances Act 2012;

so that public sector employer superannuation guarantee contribution rates for accumulation scheme members are aligned to the incremental increases prescribed under the Superannuation Guarantee (Administration) Act 1992 of the Commonwealth, the first of which takes effect on I July 2013.

Secondly, Section 10(3) of the Magistrates Court Act 1987, which was inadvertently removed under the Superannuation (Miscellaneous and Consequential Amendments) Act 2000, will be reinstated with retrospective effect. This will remove any doubt that a Magistrate who was a member of the Contributory Scheme before it was closed, may remain in the Scheme.
