I write to outline my opposition to the proposed \$750 million stadium at Macquarie Point.

I was wondering if the Parliament has forgotten what it's purpose is? It's purpose is not to support a private company with a revenue of \$740 million with public money and public land. It's purpose is the exact opposite. To put the money in the community where it's actually needed. It is an insult that this project has progressed this far. We have 2 perfectly viable venues for AFL in this state. The games do not attract large crowds, making this proposal even more dubious.


As a taxpayer I object to public funding going towards this project when thousands of Tasmanians can't get a home, more than 55,000 Tasmanians are on the health waiting list to see a specialist and the cost of living is making life harder for more and more Tasmanians.

The AFL shouldn't be making Tasmanians pay for a new roofed stadium to have our own Tasmanian team. No other state has been made to do this. Tasmanians have not been consulted on the chosen site and I do not support the decision made by the government.

The government has not presented a business case that outlines the merits of this project or explained why our state should be burdened with further debt when the state already has two AFL standard stadiums, one in the north and one in the south that will now go to waste.

Another stadium is the wrong priority for our state.
